Presenter: Dr. David Weisoly Topic: New Business 2024 Smart Goals	Dr. Weisoly started the meeting with letting the members know that this meeting is basically everything neonatal. The workgroup previously called Perinatal QI workgroup and is now the Neonatal subcommittee, which will include all the neonatal workgroups and database updates that will report out to this subcommittee. Presenter: Dr. M Singhal/ Joy Greenberg Topic: Antibiotic Timeliness Workgroup Update	Joy Greenberg showed slides on their mission statement and goals. She showed slides and discussed the data trend from 2019-2023. Joy shared with the group the PAS 2024 project goal was accepted. She showed slides on Percentage of Antibiotics given more than 1hr (birth to 7 DOL) from 2019-2022. She showed slides on Delay's in antibiotic administration in first week of life. Some delays were lack of data, communication errors, lack of collaboration, environment, pharmacy challenges, and IV access challenges. Joy reviewed an antibiotics timeliness survey with the members. She also talked about upcoming group meetings, with different hospitals scheduled to share their success stories and struggles. Dr. Singhal thanked Joy for presenting and thanked those that completed the survey. Dr. Singhal agreed with Joy that we need more awareness to all NICU's, reminding all of the SETRAC toolkit to help all get to giving antibiotics within an hour. She stated that goal is to reach out to each NICU to make them aware of all resources that's available.	The committee has no further recommendations

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Presenter: Dr. Tiffany Molina/ Dr. R Rawalt Topic: Breastmilk at Discharge Workgroup Update	Dr. Tiffany Molina didn't have slides today, she did share their project was accepted for PAS 2024. She thanked all members for the roles, especially the data base workgroup and SETRAC efforts. She stated the next schedule meeting is February 13 th . She stated at the next meeting they will work to set up their 2024 itemized and specific goals for postpartum updates and NICU interventions. Once that has been established there will be a new survey to put that information out to all. The purpose is to make sure everyone is on the same page and to keep track on progressing forward. Presenter: Dr. Fry/ Dr. Kulkarni/ Grace Farquhar Topic: Data Update	Grace gave the data update on Q3-2023, which was due November 30 th . She stated there is 1 hospital on neonatal side and 1 on maternal, that is still missing data. Other than that, all hospitals are current. Grace stated the 2 hospital that are missing data has been notified. Grace thanked all facilities that has submitted data. She reminded that members that Q4-2023 data is due at the end of February 2024. She stated that reminders will go out through the data base to those facilities. She stated that Q4-2024 is the last time data will be collected on the cephalosporin question. The January data will have the 2 new questions on breastmilk at discharge. She stated that there will be revision to the data dictionary so that it has the 2 new breastmilk at discharge questions and the cephalosporin question will be removed.
