The idea is to do a collaboration with all the service lines Stroke, Cardiac and Perinatal. The goal is to provide education, resources, a BP log, as well as BP monitors. Melanie asked for volunteers or anyone that is interested in being a part of this program. Working the cardiac booth, taking blood pressure or teaching Hands Only CPR. Once that date is established a volunteer signup will be sent out. SETRAC believes this would be a great opportunity for the committees to get out in the communities to give education and awareness to underprivileged neighborhoods. Kristine Macalalad from HCA Tomball started with sharing that HCA Tomball has been officially re-accredited as a nationally recognized Chest Pain Center. She showed slides on the NCDR AMI performance. She showed slides and explained their process for STEMI's. ED STEMI's and Inpatient STEMI's. Kristine reviewed slides and showed the HCA STEMI Process checklist and Core Measure Checklist. She presented a slide showing a chart of US Hospital R4Q Performance Distribution. Kristine stated one of her goals is to increase Cardiac Rehabilitation attendance. There were a few questions and open discussion on this presentation. There was a request for the slides from Kristine to be shared with the members. For old business, Rebecca reviewed the best practice calendar with the members. She reminded the members of a previous issue with arrival mode vs. total STEMI's the numbers were off, that issue is now being corrected as there will be a validation now. She talked about still waiting for the agreement with NCDR to be established. She encouraged all the members to start thinking about data points and metrics that they might have an interest in looking further into. Rebecca stated she didn't have much of an update on NCDR, however she did open the floor for all the members to brainstorm or share ideas from their campus that they wanted to discuss on this topic. The members spoke and shared on different EKG processes and challenges at their facilities. There was a question from a member on "what exactly is NCDR really trying to get at?" there was open discussion on that question. A few members gave there take on NCDR. There were lots of discussion between the members on EMS transport and 1st EKG tracking in the ED. A member shared information on the State of TX as they are trying to reduce the cost for hospitals and make sure patients are being treated in a timely manner. A link was left in the chat for the members to review. Rebecca mentioned that after great discussions, we always bring up more problems and barriers. She suggested that members continue to discuss and try to find an avenue, whether it is reaching out to NCDR directly or taking the concerns to their chest pain teams at their facilities to bring awareness to these topics of concern.
