Presenter: Dr. Kevin Schulz Topic: Call to Order/Approval of Minutes	Dr. Schulz welcome everyone with a Happy NewYear for 2024.The minutes from the October 20, 2023, meeting was approved as written. Presenter: Dr. Kevin Schulz Dr. James McCarthy Topic: New Business - o QI Referrals - o New Physician Co-Chair	Dr. Schulz introduced Melanie to discuss the QI program to the members. Melanie presented a link on the SETRAC website, so all members would have access to it. She informed all members if there are cases, trends or any events where there might be concerns, these things can now be referred to the QI program. Dr. Schultz added this would be useful to report trends as well share major incidents that happen where we can look at multi-disciplinary point of views. Dr. Schultz introduced the members to Dr. Sanket Borgaonkar who has stepped up for the opening position, Physician Co-Chair for this Cardiac Committee. Dr. Borgaonkar introduced himself and gave a little background on his experience. He is excited to be a part of the committee. Presenter: Timothy Sphar Topic: Best Practice Presentation o Memorial Hermann Sugarland	Timothy Sphar from Memorial Hermann Sugarland did present on Chest Pain Program Data Dissemination and Accountability. He showed slides and reviewed the spreadsheets he uses for data to review and analyze metrics. He stated the expectation is anything that's required to be done is charted and taken care of within 24hrs. Timothy stated this process is his best practice because this expectation of accountability has made the overall program more successful across the campus. Presenter: Dr. James McCarthy Topic: GETAC Update	Dr. McCarthy reported for the first time ever we are finally getting statewide cardiac data through the EMS registry. He stated that GETAC will be looking at statewide and regionally sliced data from pre- hospital providers that will be pushed back to the RAC'S. He mentioned specific data areas that we need to look at that will be sent to SETRAC. More to come on that.	The committee has no further recommendations



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Presenter: Carrie Boyd/Rebecca Nutt Topic: STEMI Coordinator Subcommittee Co-leader Needed	Rebecca Nutt recapped the last subcommittee meeting. She mentioned the Heart of the Matter program, which is a collaboration between cardiac, stroke and perinatal. The program will give education on stroke education and hands only CPR. They are still looking for volunteers. Rebecca talked about the best practice calendar and how helpful the presentations has been. Rebecca talked about Grace's update on data from the last meeting. She mentioned how great it was that we had 99% of data reported. Rebecca also talked about prehospital EKG process mapping., which is a new NCDR requirement. She stated there is still brainstorming and conversations on this topic, so more to come on this. There was a question on how as a committee, we can educate the ER Physicians on this topic? There were open discussions on this topic between the members.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Kevin Schulz/Melanie Aluotto Topic: Education Workgroup Hands-Only CPR	Dr. Schulz mentioned there are local medical schools in Houston, that might be interested in collaboration in the Hands-Only CPR. Melanie presented on the Heart of Matter program. She slowed slides and reviewed maps showing the targeted areas based on zip codes, that has the highest risk factors for stroke. The goal is to eventually cover the entire region. SETRAC still need volunteers for this program, specifically for hands only CPR. Melanie stated that she has applied for 5 different grants. She currently has blood pressure logs to give out and 50 blood pressure donated by HEB. As of now, the time date and location are unconfirmed, there were questions and open discussion on this topic. Melanie stated she has a meeting scheduled with Best Learning Solutions, a company that has volunteered to assist with Hands-Only CPR. Once SETRAC has date and location solidified the sign up for volunteers will be sent out.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Olga Ortega Cynthia Hernandez Topic: Standing Reports Q3 2023 Regional Data Review	Olga Ortega presented on the Q3 2023 Regional Data. She reminded all facilities to submit their data. Olga state that she continues to reach out to facilities that need to submit data. She showed slides on Direct presentation STEMI patients from Q1 2019 to Q3 2023, still trending down from previous quarters. Olga showed slides on Total STEMIs Q1-	The committee has no further recommendations



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	2019 to Q3-2023...continue to trend down compared to pre-pandemic numbers. She questioned if reason for the decline was maybe due to facilities not submitting data. She slowed slides on Direct presentation STEMI patients with Delay in receiving PCI. There was lots of open discussion on acceptable vs. nonacceptable reasons for delay. Slides were shown on Q3 2023 comparative reports. She showed slides on Transferred STEMI patients with Delay in receiving PCI Q1 2019- Q3 2023. Slides were also shown on Total STEMI transferred for PCI, First Facility DIDO, and First Facility Lytics Administration for Q1 2019 to Q3 2023. Olga also showed slides on Lytics Administration at referring facilities. Both Freestanding ED's and Non-PCI Hospitals were discussed. She showed there are a large # of people not getting Lytics. The collection of patient level data (no PHI) will assist in determining what factors may be impacting these numbers. Olga showed a slide on Lytics administration rates at referring facilities as it continues to be low. There were questions and open discussion about the data shown.

Dr. Schulz gave the update, we are started to look at statewide data from multiple sources. One of them is Texas cares.
