The idea is to do a collaboration with all the service lines Stroke, Cardiac and Perinatal. The goal is to provide education, resources, a BP log, as well as BP monitors. Melanie stated that we are still working on a location. Cynitha stated her church is interested, but it's a very large church. She needs more information on how we would manage the crowd. She will meet with Melanie to discuss in more details and follow-up with her church, as they are interested in hosting a Hands-only CPR event. She asked for volunteers or anyone that is interested in being a part of this program. Working the cardiac booth, taking blood pressure or teaching Hands Only CPR. Melanie showed a slide with the QR code for anyone interested in signing up. She also mentioned the NASCAR Giveathon. Cynitha's first slide was the problem statement which she talked about back in 2019 upon review of the NCDR CP/MI registry it was observed that patients diagnosed with Type 1 Myocardial Infarction, especially Non-ST Elevation Myocardial Infarction NSTEMI cases, were actually Demand Ischemia Type II.
