Presenter: Carrie Boyd/Rebecca Nutt Topic: Welcome and Introductions	Rebecca Nutt welcomed everyone. The meeting minutes from the March 6, 2024, were approved with no changes. Reminder to log attendance at www.setrac.org/cardiac .	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Melanie Aluotto Topic: New Business - Heart of the Matter Presenter: Daryl Dawn Hausler Topic: Best Practice Presentation - HCA Houston Healthcare Conroe	Melanie talked about the Heart of The Matter Event on April 5th at Top Ladies of Distinction and Top Teens of America event. Hands Only CPR was taught to 234 teenagers. She talked about how successful the event was and shared data and pictures. Melanie also reminded the members the next upcoming Heart of The Matter event is on May 29th at 55+ community. She asked and shared a QR code for any volunteers interested in volunteering to sign up. Daryl Hausler quality manager from HCA Houston Healthcare Conroe presented on Improving Cardiac Patient Post-Discharge Medication Compliance through the implementation of a discharge checklist. She stated they implemented this checklist to improve medication compliance. Daryl shared their aim statement: "In cardiac patients treated for STEMI and NSTEMI, we will increase the percentage of statins at discharge by 10% by January 31, 2024." Daryl showed slides with their methods, which includes a checklist into the metrics, performance data and discharge readiness checklist. Registered nurses collaborated with hospitalist and cardiologist, and performance data was shared at various stakeholder meetings. She shared data results. The findings were for Q3-2023 through Q1-2024 to date the overall percentage of guidelines medications prescribed at discharge for patients seen in the Cath lab increased from 85.1% to 94.6%. From Q3-2023 through Q1-2024 to date the overall percentage of statins prescribed at discharge for patients seen in the Cath lab increased from 85.9% to 94.6%. From Q3-2023 through Q1-2024 to date the overall percentage of statins prescribed at discharge for inpatients increased from 92.5% to 100%. Daryl talked about what's important to make this whole process a success. Multidisciplinary stakeholder engagement is vital to the success of this program, as well as data literacy and transparency which is a key indicator of the program's success and positive patient outcomes.
