Reviewed ACS common findings: Alcohol misuse interventions, documented effectiveness of the PIPS program, alcohol misuse screening, trauma registry patient record completion, mental health screening, certified abbreviated injury scale specialist, neurosurgeon response time, Trauma multidisciplinary PIPs committee attendance, trauma registry staffing requirements and trauma registry course. From 111 re-verification/verification surveys 47% have been given focused visits and 6% have not been designated. Additional stated ACS is looking at a 3 tier IR response.
