Presenter: Melanie Aluotto Topic: New Business - Coordinator of the Year Nominees - Coordinator of the Year	Melanie informed the members; SETRAC wants to recognize coordinators that were nominated for coordinator of the year. Presenter: Melanie Aluotto Topic: Old Business - QI Referral Program - Heart of the Matter Program	Melanie reminded the members of the QI program. Melanie presented a link on the SETRAC website, so all members would have access to it. She informed all members if there are cases, trends or any events where there might be concerns, these things can now be referred to the QI program. Melanie presented on the Heart of Matter program. The goal is to eventually cover the entire region with outreach on Stroke and Cardiac education, specifically on stroke risk factors, teaching hands-only CPR, and giving out blood pressure cuffs to those in need. Presenter: Carrie Boyd/Rebecca Nutt Topic: STEMI Coordinator Subcommittee	Rebecca Nutt recapped the last subcommittee meeting. She mentioned the Heart of the Matter program, which is a collaboration between cardiac, stroke and perinatal. She talked about her experience at the last Heart of the Matter Event. Rebecca believed the event was a great success. Rebecca recapped on the subcommittee last meeting. She talked about the best practice presentations and how beneficial it has been to hear and share stories with other facilities. She stated there are continued discussions on the new NCDR EMS EKG process. She reminded members of the data updates and due dates, and she briefly mentioned CEO reports and the leadership looking forward to those reports to see how they are benchmarking across other campuses. She stated there was talk about a data dictionary being updated to coincide with NDCR. Grace gave input that CEO reports have been set out at this point, to the CEO. She told the members if any facility didn't receive it, please let SETRAC know. She stated CEO report is online showing data from Q1-Q4 2023 data, however its password protected. Grace also stated the SETRAC data dictionary will definitely be updated. She stated there are many updates to make, being that SETRAC now has a signed agreement with NCDR. Presenter: Cynthia Hernandez Topic: Standing Reports Q1 2024 Regional Data Review	Cynthia Hernandez presented on the Q1 2024 Regional Data. She started with showing slides on total hospital submissions from Q1-2019 to Q1-2024. Slides were shown on Total STEMIs Q1-2019 to Q1-2024 Direct presentation STEMI patients from Q1 2019 to Q1 2024, now trending up from previous quarters. She slowed slides on Direct presentation vs STEMI transferred in, the data show, there is not much change. Cynthia showed a slide on arrival method and noted this is a place of concern as the data shows EMS transport is trending down, and private transportation is trending up. She talked about this being an area to focus on. There was open conversation between the members on educating patients on the importance of calling 911, vs driving	The committee recommended getting a card or flyer out to promote the importance of calling 911 vs driving to the Emergency Room.



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	themselves to the hospital. Dr. Schulz suggested getting someone from EMS to partner with our Heart of the Matter program to get more information out to the community on the importance of calling EMS for transport in emergencies. Cynitha showed slides on Q1-2019-Q1-2024 acceptable vs. nonacceptable reasons for delay, reasons for No PCI (direct presentations), reason for delay in receiving PCI (direct presentation). Cynitha showed the Q1 2024 Comparative Report D2B analysis of STEMI patients. Cynitha mentioned the goal of greater than 90% for Total D2B. She stated we have been well over 90% for a few years. Currently at 95.2%. Cynitha asked this group to consider setting a new goal of 97%, which would be the best. Grace gave input on waiting for the access to NCDR to review the data first, she stated after reviewing our data for the region we can make a decision after. She showed slides on Transferred STEMI patients with Delay in receiving PCI Q1 2019- Q1 2024. Slides were also shown on Total STEMI transferred for PCI, First Facility DIDO, and First Facility Lytics Administration for Q1 2019 to Q1 2024. She also showed slides on Lytics Administration at referring facilities. Both Freestanding ED's and Non-PCI Hospitals were discussed. She showed there are a large # of people not getting Lytics. Freestanding ED has 94% that's not getting lytics and Non-PCI hospitals has 64% that's not getting lytics. Slides were shown on STEMI patients delay in receiving PCI Q1-2019-Q1-2024 and the reasons for No PCI. There was lots of questions and open discussion between the members on the shown data.	There committee recommendation is to create a workgroup to review NCDR data once available.
Presenter: Kim Hermie Topic: Texas CARES Data	Kim Kermie from STRAC introduced herself as the new person that will be presenting and sharing Texas Cares Data. She informed the members she is here to help with any data SETRAC might need. Kim showed slides and reviewed the 2023 Texas Cares Data. Kim showed slides on Patient Demographics with data from SETRAC, Texas, and National. She informed the members if there is any specific data points SETRAC needs, she can get like gender and age, locations. Kim showed a slide on Prehospital Metrics % Bystander CPR-(SETRAC 48.1, Texas 44.4,	The committee has no further recommendations



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	National 41.4) Bystander AED-(SETRAC 2.0, Texas, 1.8, National 1.6) Initial Shockable Rhythm- (SETRAC 15.7, Texas 16.7, National 17.6) ROSC- (SETRAC 26.6, Texas, 25.2, National 27.1). Survival % to Admission – (SETRAC 28.3, Texas, 24.8, National 26.0) To discharge- (SETRAC 12.1, Texas 10.5, National 10.2) With CPC 1 or 2- (SETRAC 8.2, Texas 7.8, National 8.1) Utstein- SETRAC 32.1, Texas, 29.8 National 32.5).
