Presenter: Joyce Cabriana/ Lady Brenda Boateng Topic: Stroke Education Workgroup - HCA Houston Healthcare Kingwood	Joyce Cabriana, Stroke Coordinator from HCA Houston Healthcare Kingwood presented on their best practice "Kingwood Stroke Process". She started with defining Door to needle time, which refers to the amount of time before the administering Tenecteplase to a potential stroke patient. The goal is 90% on Tenecteplase case be < 60 minutes. HCA Kingwood strive to accomplish this in 30 minutes, and anything over 45 minutes is reviewed by the stroke coordinator. Joyce showed slides on Code neuro to ELVO, showing their process. She stated they strive to have stroke care standardized. To accomplish this, they follow algorithms and checklist to be when caring for stroke patients.	The committee has no further recommendations
