Presenter: Eric Parmley Topic: Texas Pediatric Readiness Improvement Project Presenter: Robin Hazlett Topic: PECC Update	Eric reported that the Texas Pediatric Readiness Improvement Project monthly education series occurs on the third Thursday of every month at 7:00am. Robin Hazlett the regional PECC for SETRAC advised she has worked with Matagorda Regional Medical Center to complete their Pediatric Readiness survey and also help with education. She will be following up with the SIMS exercises during September. The point of the project is to get everyone ready and comfortable working with pediatric patients. She encouraged everyone to start doing the simulations as soon as possible to get in the rhythm of doing them twice a year. All hospitals, pediatric and adult need to be ready for a pediatric emergency as parents tend to bring their children to the nearest hospital, not necessarily the nearest appropriate hospital. Houston Methodist did their first SIMs August 19 th and ready to do more. Robin is available to help onboard any Emergency Room or Free-Standing ER or even Urgent Care. She offered her business card she's easy to work with and willing to drive to where she is needed. She has done some cold calls no one has answered or returned her call maybe it's the 412-area code if a 412-area code comes across, please answer. Suzanne advised that the PECC is a mandate from the state and will be included in the new rules in some way. Suzanne asked how many in the meeting had completed their pediatrics readiness survey. Robin does not have access to the scores but will go over it with them to help them improve if needed. Robin mentioned the SIM box website where everybody has access. The goal is Robin will do one with everybody to see how they are set up (Pedi cart, education, all nurses have PALs, etc.).
