Presenter: Dr. Davis Topic: New Business 2025 Committee Nominees 1-2 Minute Speech	Suzanne advised that voting would take place at all the committee meetings for new leadership for 2025-2026. Presenter: Robin Hazlett Topic: Pediatric Readiness Update PECC	Robin Hazlett advised she is the only regional PECC currently. They need 2-3 PEECs. She welcomes any help as she will be going on maternity leave at the end of February. The Texas Readiness improvement project seeks to support all Texas trauma centers to achieve high levels of pediatric readiness (even if they are not designated as a pediatric trauma center but take care of pediatric patients' example children with seizures, respiratory problems, abuse, or any child that walks through the door). Pediatric Emergency Care Coordinators and Pediatric Quality Improvement efforts are the foundational steps to sustain pediatric readiness. 	across the state to ensure Texas leads the nation in its commitment to high quality emergency care for every child. As the regional PECC Robin helps all hospitals whether an adult, freestanding, and/or a children's facility. She is here to help to improve the pediatric care for patients. The end of the grant is coming up she would like for each hospital to have their own PEEC to continue the work of taking care of pediatric patients. It is not just a Texas project it is going nationwide there are working on it in Michigan and Washington, and Georgia is looking into it. It's a big thing that everybody wants to work on. Parents go to the nearest hospital if their child has an emergency. She was trained in March she's been working on it since January. Our RAC should have 3 regional PEECs. Her goal is to get more people scheduled for initial meetings, she will work around schedules, visit facilities, and help with the pediatric readiness score and virtual SIMS. She wants to establish a H-PECC in each facility and they can then take the lead on pediatric readiness. Out of 52 hospitals she's had contact with 10 hospitals and have had 4 pediatric simulations. She talked to Suzanne about hosting a train the trainer at the RAC if the committee is interested, please reach out to her.
