The following topics were presented at the subcommittee meeting: • <u>DNR Initiative Discussion</u> Discussion around DNR's and how the committee can standardize (regionally) the process of how DNR's are getting to the right care providers at the right time during resuscitation efforts for pre-hospital providers. Discussion around the File of Life non-profit organization that allows first responders to obtain medical information when patients are unable to do so. This is a magnet style envelope with pertinent medical information about patient. There was discussion around getting a different or regional "DNR" style envelope or card style to provide to various special population groups. There was discussion around cost burden to being the custodian of the envelopes/cards to the providers and reach out to different partners to assist with this. A question was posed if there were any other vendors that have this type of product already. Discussion around using SETRAC online store as a central location for organizations to obtain this product if one is created.	No action items or recommendations.	Closed.

<u>Fall Prevention</u> Grace from SETRAC presented the injury heat map on the SETRAC website that allows partners to view top injuries in their district based on zip codes. MIH can utilize this information as the intervention arm to assist with this common injury type. Grace gave an overview of the process of data behind this. The heat map is located on the SETRAC website on the trauma page under resources. There was discussion about how there are hurdles to get more EMS data to provide for this topic at the SETRAC level, and how SETRAC is working with different data collection groups. <u>Open Discussion</u> Corey asked for open discussion from the group and asked for updates from participants. HFD was in attendance and stated they are in the very beginning stages of starting an MIH type program internally and would love to get help and feedback. The group provided some ideas on how to start and ideas on different programs where they could begin. HCESD11 stated they are also in the beginning stages and currently looking at addresses with high utilization of EMS services. Guidelines were approved and their medical director is a supporter of this program. Sam Scarber with North Channel stated they are working towards working with community partners and furthering their internal program. Corey spoke on training programs that are available online for sitting for CP-C (Community Paramedic – Certification) exam and benefits of obtaining that certification.
