The following topics were presented at the subcommittee meeting: • <u>DNR Initiative Discussion</u> Discussion around the difficulties of keeping track of individuals with DNR's and how to identify those patients in an emergency. Discussion on how the committee can standardize (regionally) the process of how DNR's are getting to the right care providers at the right time during resuscitation efforts for pre-hospital providers. Discussion from the group on how to implement a regional approach. There were suggestions from using the SETRAC Special Populations group to implement this regional approach and find the best avenue. Suggestions of getting this initiative tied to a campaign to increase awareness of code status of patients in a skilled nursing facility, etc. There was a suggestion for creating a "DNR Workgroup" under this subcommittee to work on this initiative. Discussion around creating a regional database to house this information. • <u>Definition of MIH Provider</u> The terminology and definition of an MIH Provider has already been approved by the SETRAC EMS Committee for this committee previously. It was noted that there is different terminology that agencies are using such as "Community Paramedic" that this subcommittee recognizes.	No action items or recommendations. <u>Educational & Certification Requirements for MIH Providers in the SETRAC Region</u> The group discussed the development of a regional education standard to support agencies in developing programs within their organizations. Prior to COVID, efforts were underway to develop a course with MIH educational materials to be hosted on the SETRAC Learning Management System (LMS). The goal was to establish a regional standard course specifically for MIH providers. It was noted that this initiative would serve as a benchmark to assist organizations in developing new programs or onboarding new providers that allow providers to gain access to scheduling clinicals. <u>Investigate feasibility of local educational programs</u> There was discussion around using local educational programs within the region to schedule clinical rotations for MIH providers who are signed up for the regional course as discussed above. There was discussion around that local educational programs may not be in awareness about what MIH is and its objectives.	No action items or recommendations.	Closed.
<u>Open Discussion</u> Corey asked for open discussion from the group and asked for input from the group to provide any updates from current MIH programs. There was discussion around creating a platform to share resources regionally between different programs.	Investigate avenues to provide regional platform for resource sharing.
