The second goal focused on increasing and improving participation, with the possibility of organizing a best practices presentation by each system. Members engaged in an open discussion about sharing best practices at the system level rather than individual facilities. The third goal was to host quarterly Heart of The Matter events. Rebecca also mentioned she would review the 2024 data goals to identify any metrics that could be adjusted or updated. Further open discussion took place on setting SMART goals for 2025.
