Melanie informed the group, its time to start working toward establishing smart goals for 2025. Dr. Burroughs stated they will resume discussions on smart goals at the next meeting. Dr. Aarons isn't in attendance. Dr. Burroughs topic for old business was the Primary Cesarean Rates Project. stated the overall goal as previously suggested is to identify the cesarean rates across Texas and come up with a strategic plan on how to reduce the primary cesarean rates. She stated the different reasons this is important and the clinical impact. She talked shared information on the areas of focus. Dr. Burrough shared, according to Healthy People 2030 AIMS the goals is to reduce the cesarean births among low-risk women with no prior births to 23.6% of all births to new mothers. She stated, this is the goals or metric that most of us are trying to meet. Dr. Burroughs also noted, that according to Leap Frog 2023 State of Maternity Care, in the US the average rate of NTSV C-Sections is not improving, it's getting worst. The goal is to look at those drivers while identifying areas of opportunity. She stated it's important that our definitions are clear, and we are specific in the ask from the hospitals in regard to 2yrs of data collection. The next step for this subcommittee is to have a written proposal to submit the project to SETRAC -Perinatal Committee. She asked the members for feedback. There was ideas, suggestions and open discussions between the members. Dr. Weisoly gave a brief update on the congenital syphilis project as Dr. Aarons wasn't in attendance.
