Presenter: Blake Milnes Topic: Best Practice Education EMS Pilot Project	Harris County ESD5 EMS began piloting a new home inspection/fall prevention program to assist with repeated 911 callers. The object of the program is to assist residents of our community with light maintenance of their homes (broken steps, wheelchair ramps, tripping hazards, etc.) as well as educate them on falls and how to prevent them.
