Presenter: Dr. Catherine Epps/Dr. Kelli Burroughs Topic: TCHMB Update-OB Committee Update	that project up as all that data has been collected. Presenter: Grace Farquhar Data Updates/ CEO Reports	Grace started with the SETRAC database summary. She showed data submissions as of yesterday 3.4.25. The data reviewed from Q1-2019 to Q4-2024 for Neonatal. She stated that number of submissions decreased in 2024. Grace stated there are a few hospitals that still haven't submitted their Q4 data which was due last week. Grace reminded the members about that the goal is to turn the screen green. For maternal she showed data from Q3-2021 to Q4-2024. She reminded all that Data submission is required for SETRAC participation letters. She shared the due dates for each quarter. She talked about successful NRP classes that were held and upcoming NRP classes that are scheduled for 2025. Jennifer also shared her poster project based on the data from the SETRAC NRP classes. Presenter: Dr. Kelli Burroughs/ Aaron Roberts Topic: Maternal Subcommittee Update	Dr. Burroughs talked about the NTSV Cesarean Rate QI Project. Dr. Burroughs shared, according to Healthy People 2030 AIMS the goal is to reduce the cesarean births among low-risk women with no prior births to 23.6% of all births to new mothers. She stated, this is the goal or metric that most of us are trying to meet. Dr. Burroughs also noted, that according to Leap Frog 2023 State of Maternity Care, in the US the average rate of NTSV C-Sections is not improving, it's getting worse. The goal is to look at those drivers while identifying areas of opportunity. She showed some data charts from 2015-2022. The plan is to review data, identify areas of opportunity and implementation of a process to improve these outcomes. Dr. Roberts briefly talked about the collaboration with the neonatal and maternal groups on congenital syphilis. Dr. Roberts stated there was a very productive meeting with the Houston Health Department, the neonatal and maternal partners. More to come.	The committee has no further recommendations

He talked about what the causes of the accident. He talked about and compared the airport structure to hospital structure in the event of a major accident or tragedy. Presenter: Dr. Ballard/Dr. Amy Tsai Topic: Infant Mortality & Morbidity Workgroup	Dr. Rebecca Ballard recapped what this workgroup is working on. She talked about the Congenital Syphilis Project. She talked about why it's so important to work with the Maternal Workgroup and the Houston Health Department on this topic. Dr. Amy Tsai showed slides and gave a reminder on why they chose to work on this project. She stated the goal is to decrease the rates of congenital syphilis. She discussed and gave an update on the previously workgroup meetings, she reminded all, this a combined project between maternal and neonatal. Dr. Tsai discussed the phases. She stated they start with the reporting phase-gathering data and a taking survey. Then the intervention phase- based on the data and the education/awareness and a possible toolkit. Dr. Tsai stated a survey was sent out from SETRAC and ask all members to please complete survey. Dr. Tsai shared their long-term plans which included, working on a survey and proposal for data collection. She talked about the proposed data points- (initial baseline data) and asked for a vote on what data points the workgroup should start with. There was lots of open discussion between the members. The group agreed to add the data points to the collection. Dr. Tsai reminded all about the Fetal and Infant Morbidity Review scheduled for tomorrow and she gave the hotline number for all interested in attending.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Dr. Tiffany Molina/Dr. Rawalt Topic: Breastmilk at Discharge Project Update	Dr. Molina stated that she has seen some great changes with getting the data submitted. Dr. Molina reviewed the Q1-2019-Q3-2024 NICU babies discharged on any breastmilk slides. The goal is to get at least 75% of all babies discharged on any breastmilk, we are currently at 69% percent 2024 YTD. Dr. Molina showed a slide that is concerning, with a significant drop. VLBW babies discharged on any breastmilk regional goal is >55%. In 2023 we were 57.3%. We are currently at 46.3% in 2024. She stated this is something to focus on, to get this number back up in the new year. The project aim is by 1/2025 to increase/maintain the percentage of infants discharged from SETRAC NICU's on breastmilk as follows: All NICU admits	The committee has no further recommendations



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	(SETRAC Goal >75%) VLBW (BW<1500g) (SETRAC Goal >55%). Dr. Molina shared the 2024 data on the new metric - Breastmilk at 28 DOL or Discharge. Its still in the data gathering stage. Currently data shows for the 1 st 3Q's of 2024 data, 69.5% all birthweights and 63.2 % VLBW. Dr. Molina stated the focus in 2025 is: Pump at discharge and NICU EBM target logs and GOMOM tool. Dr. Molina shared the Breastmilk Project Survey Reviews with the members and thanked everyone who participated for their feedback. She discussed the project goals and aims, focused strategies for L&D, focused strategies for postpartum, and focused strategies for NICU. The next meeting is April 8, 2025.	
Presenter: Dr. Nuthakki /Joy Greenberg, PHARM-D Topic: Antibiotics Timeliness Project	Joy Greenberg started her presentation with a reminder of the project goals. The goal percentage of NICU infants receiving antibiotics in the first week of life more than 1h after order/birth (if order placed prior to birth). They previously voted on a new project goal to decrease the percentage to 25% by December 2025. She discussed tiered strategies for improvement. Joy showed slides on Neonatal Data Q1-2019- Q3-2024. We are currently at 29% close to the 25% goal. She showed slides on the percentage of NICU infants receiving antibiotics. Joy showed slides on the data trend. She also talked about project group updates, goals and sharing hospital program success stories and struggles, as well as additional data measurement. Joy reviewed the December survey results and thanked everyone that completed the survey. Joy talked about their upcoming projects. She shared a slide with their poster project and talked about the successful presentation at the Neonatal Conference.
