Presenter: Dr. Sushma Nuthakki/ Joy Greenberg Topic: Antibiotic Timeliness Workgroup Update	Joy Greenberg shared slides and talked about this workgroup's smart goal to decrease the percentage of NICU infants receiving antibiotics in the first week of life more than 1hr after birth to 25% by December 2025. Joy reviewed slides with the data from Q1-2019 to Q4-2024. She talked about the antibiotics toolkit and some additions that were recently added. Some additions are contact info, data tracking tool expanded, hey driver diagram, nurse education handouts, PIV escalation algorithms, vascular access algorithm and the updated SETRAC antibiotics timeliness poster. Joy also mentioned upcoming projects: working on manuscripts for publication and working on the hospital reference guide, that programs can focus on. She offered any hospital that's interested in presenting their best practice the opportunity to do so.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Dr. A. Tsai/ Dr. Rebecca Ballard Topic: Infant Morbidity & Mortality Workgroup Update	Dr. Tsai reviewed the results from the Congenital Syphilis survey that was sent out to 13 facilities. She stated they are currently working on reviewing the data points on both the Neonatal and Maternal side to discuss possible project ideas. Dr. Tsai stated the 2025 Goal is to decrease the Congenital Syphilis rates.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Dr. Tiffany Molina/ Dr. R Rawalt Topic: Breastmilk at Discharge Workgroup Update	Dr. Tiffany Molina reviewed the Q1-2019-Q4-2024 Neonatal Data on NICU Babies Discharged on any Breastmilk. Total Inborn & Outborn NICU Patients Regional Goal: in January 2022->80% Regional Goal: January 2024 >75%. Total Inborn & Outborn VLBW Patients Discharged from the NICU Regional Goal: January 2022->40%	The committee has no further recommendations

She also reviewed the 1 st year of data for NICU Babies Discharged Receiving Any Mothers Own Milk at 28DOL or Discharge in 2024: All BW 68.5% and VLBW 64.8%. Dr. Molina summarized the focus strategies of 2024. She thanked everyone that responded to the surveys and reviewed the data results with the members. Dr. Molina also shared the 2025 focused strategies with the areas for improvement. She reminded all the members about Kangaroo Care Day, tomorrow May 15 th and invited all to participate.
