Presenter: Dr. Nichole Davis Topic: New Business - Community Flyer for CYSHCN - Discuss Potential for Improving Capacity at Medical Shelters in Surrounding Counties - Call for Workgroup Volunteers - PDPACH PPN – Pediatric Disaster Preparedness	- Community Flyer for CYSHCN Still in conversations with SETRAC committees for a specific flyer for families at a medical shelter to use as a resource. We know there is a gap in education regarding where to go, what to bring, and who can come with them. The goal is a possible infographic, or education sheet so that if you must go to one of these facilities you know how to be prepared. They will be working with our EMS and ED partners to make this happen. This is a little bit of a double-edged sword since hospitals do not want the community to think THEY are a medical shelter. They also hope to start the conversations on expanding what/who families can bring to shelters. Dr. Davis asked if this is something that someone in the committee is interested in or has a passion for, to please email her or Suzanne. - Discuss Potential for Improving Capacity at Medical Shelters in Surrounding Counties - Call for Workgroup Volunteers - PDPACH PPN – Pediatric Disaster Preparedness - This allows respondents to access a real time QI dashboard of disaster preparedness. Allows facilities that participate to see how they rate, see progress, and hope to improve disaster preparedness within your hospital. This also promotes collaboration among pediatric facilities, offers resources in professional development to participating facilities, and can bring in the SME to evaluate and help with resources. 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○ NPRQI ○ Goal Greater Than Five Hospitals to Sign Up ○ Open Discussion	not completed their pediatric readiness survey and is that bring communicated to the TPM? Unfortunately, no, the center must reach out to the PRISMs. There isn't a database to access. ○ Trauma rules - since it was dropped to two scenarios a year, they must be trauma. ○ Discussed Survey NPRQI ○ We know 76% mortality reduction in hospitals with high pediatric readiness scores. This organization gets you access to the QI database. You can choose from vetted quality metrics to benchmark yourself over time. This is a way that these general EDs can start participating in pediatric specific QI metrics. ○ Currently have no hospitals in our RAC signed up. If your facility has a PECC they should know about this organization. It was discussed at the board meeting and at GETAC that we have no participation. Goal - Greater than five hospitals to sign up before the next board meeting. Discussion about bringing this information to the ED committee. This initiative has been pushed from trauma and has been included in the new trauma rules to encourage emergency department participation. Dr. Davis will reach out to the ED committee and share some information.
