Dr. Burroughs topic for old business was the Primary Cesarean Rates Project. She stated the overall goal as previously suggested is to identify the cesarean rates across Texas and come up with a strategic plan on how to reduce the primary cesarean rates. She presented the written Proposal to present to SETRAC, which highlights the project. Project Title: Reducing Low-Risk Cesarean Deliveries: A Multi-Hospital Evaluation of NTSV Rates in the SETRAC Region. She talked about the purpose of the project. Dr. Burrough shared, according to Healthy People 2030 AIMS the goals is to reduce the cesarean births among low-risk women with no prior births to 23.6% of all births to new mothers. Dr. Burroughs talked about the objective, project design, data collections period, population definition, data parameters and data privacy. The next steps are to send this written proposal to SETRAC for approval. Dr. Aarons talked about the IV fluid project. He stated he will be closing out this project as most facilities are no longer dealing with an IV Fluids shortage. He stated there is now a tool kit for future incidents that might cause IV Fluid shortage again. Dr. Aaron talked about the Congenital Syphilis Project, which is a collaboration with the Neonatal partners. He recapped their last meeting, which they discussed data definitions. He shared this information with the members and stated this information will be sent out as a usable document to all regional sites.	The committee has no further recommendations.
