Call to Order

Janay Yancey called the meeting to order at 2:01 pm.

Minutes (C101)

Ms. Yancey requested review of the May minutes. Jonathan Walker (Nacogdoches County EMS) made a motion to approve the minutes, Ken Jobe (CHI St. Luke's Lufkin) seconded the motion, and the corridor members carried the motion. The minutes were approved as written.

New Business

How the New Trauma Rules Will Affect EMs

Gary Litton (SETRAC) gave an update on the Hospital Regional Disaster Committee's new trauma rules and reviewed how the rules could affect emergency managers.

HPP Capabilities Review (C101)

Texas Hill Country Update

SETRAC has assets deployed with two ambulance strike teams, an AMBUS, approximately three MIST personnel, two portable morgue units, and a few SETRAC staff members were requested to help with the MCI.

• Pulsara Update

Jax Kincaid is now over the Houston and Dallas area, which adds a lot of users to her area of responsibility, but Mr. Litton is working with her to ensure issues are being resolved.

• World Cup Update

Mr. Litton reminded the corridor members that the World Cup is scheduled from June 11 through July 19, 2026, which will be 45 days of games and activities. Lori Upton and Lisa Spivey sit on one of the World Cup committees and are keeping the regions updated.

Corridor Chair/Co-chair Elections

Mr. Litton reported that SETRAC recently conducted the corridor chair/co-chair nominations and elections, and he announced Stephen Bennett as North Corridor Chair and Janay Yancey as North Co-chair again for the next three-year term.

End of Year Spending

The SETRAC fiscal year ended in June and end of year spending was put together by a committee formed to make the final decisions. Mr. Litton stated he pushed for PAPRs to receive filters throughout the region for decon training and they were approved and ordered. There will be about three boxes of filters per facility in the North Corridor area which comes to approximately \$1800 per facility. He also advised there may be enough funds left to purchase one radio (approximately \$5000 each) per facility for the current 800-megahertz system.

HPP Funding Cuts

Mr. Litton reported that on the most recent HPP call DSHS stated the funding will last all the way through to June 2026. SETRAC did receive the HPP funding information, and it was at 67%

leaving the HPP funding at 33% less for the year. The funding source has switched from HHS to CDC and in talking with SETRAC leadership, they are not 100% this is the final amount.

EMTF Update (C306)
