Presenter: Liza Hinojosa Topic: New Business Presentation on NRPQI	Liza Hinojosa, Senior Program Coordinator presented on the National Pediatric Readiness Quality Initiative (NPRQI) Improving Pediatric Readiness. Liza gave a robust presentation. The NPRQI is supported by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the Toyota Way Forward Fund. It is a web-based analytics portal to assess the quality of clinical care process. QI is one of the most powerful tools for pediatric readiness which is associated with improved clinical care and outcomes for children. 85% of children are seen in the EDs that don't specialize in pediatric care across the US 76% potential mortality risk reduction among children treated in Eds with high pediatric readiness. - Pediatric Readiness Project. Assessments will be open again in March 2026. Tool kits are available on their website, as well as an ED collaborative forum for participating Emergency Departments. - NRPQI is a quality improvement resource that is data driven - NPRQI is a free self-pace platform that allows emergency rooms to look at their data in a meaningful way. To empower front line staff in best practices for pediatric patients. - NRPQI is able to visually map your data to make it meaningful and legible for frontline staff, as well as evaluate results over time. - Reviewed an NRPQI case study. - NPRQI provides coaching, tech assistance with QI and 1:1 support - Developed a Texas Trauma.
