Topic: Open Discussion	Audrey shared that the State has updated their critical congenital heart disease toolkit to 2025 recommendations, removing the second retest. The new guidelines state that if a baby's pulse ox is 89% or less in either hand, they do not retest and do not pass. The team discussed who is responsible for submitting failed CCHD screens to DSHS, with various roles mentioned including NPM, discharge coordinator, and program manager. The next meeting was scheduled for June 17th but will need to be rescheduled due to most team members being at TCHMB. There were no other open discussions between the members.
