Presenter: Kodieann Davis Topic: New Business Two School Bus Crashes	Kodieann Davis, Trauma Program Director, HCA Kingwood presented on the Cleveland ISD two school bus crashes in Cleveland, Texas FM 1010 on August 11th and 13th 2025. - There were multi agency responses on both days. - EMS wrote triage on bus windows, great in thought but unable to follow patient, second event they utilized tags. - They tried to keep kids together, with only so many school administrators that could be present. - They looked back at previous drills and incidents that worked well and implemented on the two events. - The first event did not go on internal disaster that was not communicated throughout the event (received additional trauma and STEMI). Second event went on internal disaster. - There was no need for decon at these events. - There were a dedicated nurse and MD at the doors for triage. 1 Room with no beds, only chairs for no symptoms patients that could possibly be discharged 1 room for results pending, no beds, only with chairs 1 room for OBS for mid to moderate symptoms - Second event had more yellow tags than first event - Pediatric patients pulled at the tags, identifying themselves as a possible black tag not knowing what that meant. He spoke on: • NPRP national project will be published March 2026 • Freestanding Eds account for about 21% of those visits annually, they are being included in the State assessment • New state trauma rules live Sept. 1, all levels must complete the NPRP assessment with a plan for resolution • EMS recognition program - spotlight on high medical care of pediatric patients in our pre-hospital partners • VPRP - established to provide guidance for our Emergency Rooms to care for pediatric patients.
