Presenter: Andrew Hiriart Topic: Call to Order/Approval of Minutes	Andrew Hiriart called the meeting to order. Presenter: Andrew Hiriart Topic: Coding Education	Andrew advised there was no data to review at this meeting. Data will be reviewed at the next trauma data subcommittee meeting. He discussed coding education with the committee and shared a handout with scenarios for discussion. There was an exercise done a year ago, a scenario with 10 gunshot wound injuries. The purpose was to send it out through the listserv for those who wanted to participate to code the gunshot wounds individually or by groups to see how they were coded as there are lot of different codes for the actual mechanism of injury for gunshot wounds (type of guns and intent). The exercise was to come together without educating anyone to see how they coded whether correct/incorrect and if there were any common denominators on how they were coding. They provided education at the trauma registry workshop specific to coding injuries in general with a focus on gunshot wounds as the prime example. The exercise was sent out again to everyone to redo to see the before and after and if the education was effective. Andrew is thinking the next exercise will focus on falls. He asked the committee their thoughts on the exercise. Much discussion was had. Once everyone agrees Andrew will create scenarios for the next exercise and send them out through the listservs.	The committee has no further recommendations.
