She opened the floor for feedback on what goals this committee should focus on for 2026. There was a suggestion on creating award criteria for maternal data. Dr. Burroughs thinks this is a good idea to recognize those facilities meeting metrics and developing strategies. The goals would be to continue the work on whole blood project, NTSV data project and Congenital Syphilis Project. Dr. Burroughs also provided an update on the Cesarean rate project, noting that they are close to starting data collection and will use peer comparisons to develop a toolkit for reducing primary cesarean rates, with a target benchmark of 23% based on Leapfrog standards. She stated the main goal, and major purpose is to start collecting data across SETRAC hospitals. She reviewed the objective and project design. The next steps will be submitting a written proposal to data subcommittee for review. Dr. Roberts gave an update that the Congenital Syphilis Task Force is making progress with data definitions and has developed a report and script for chart review to identify positive cases. The project aims to optimize communication and reporting of syphilis treatment in pregnancy, with data collection set to begin next quarter. Grace gave an update on the SETRAC Maternal Data Timeline. She shared that Perinatal Committee requested data be collected from each state designated maternal facility. This was approved in December 2020 and started in Q3 2021. She reminded the members that Maternal data regarding depression and substance use are no longer being collected as of June 2025. Starting January 2026 data collection will include syphilis and C-section metrics. Grace reviewed the data submissions of 2024-2025 as of 12/5/2025. She reminded all the members of the data submissions requirement for SETRAC	The committee has no further recommendations.
