Presenter: Dr. Nichole Davis Topic: Call to Order/Approval of Minutes	Dr. Nichole Davis called the meeting to order. Meeting minutes from September 4, 2025, were approved by Sarah Abbott and Hanna Urech as written. Presenter: Dr. Kevin Schulz Topic: New Business ○ FIFA ○ Plans In the Event of an MCI	Dr. Schulz introduced himself and advised of the team selection televised. He discussed the impact of hosting the FIFA games on Houston's healthcare system predicting a 5-10% increase in patient volumes due to a potential 300,000 additional people in the region over 39 days. The first game will be June 14 th with the last game being July 4 th . Houston will be the base camp for one team. He emphasized that while managing mass casualty incidents is important, the greater concern will be the overall surge in patient volumes. More to come as updates come in as they change daily. Presenter: Dr. Daniel Lemke Topic: New Business ○ New AHA/CPR Guidelines	Dr. Daniel Lemke, Associate Professor of Pediatrics, presented the AHA/ILCOR 2025 updates and reviewed the updates to PALS/BLS/ECC. <u>PALS/BLS/ECC</u> • BLS/First Aid Updates • PALS Updates • Special Situations • System issues • Education Issues Dr. Lemke covered key topics related to pediatric emergency care and resuscitation. He discussed advanced cardiovascular life support algorithms, including the use of medications like procainamide and post-arrest care guidelines. He emphasized avoiding hypotension and	The committee has no further recommendations



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	maintaining systolic blood pressure above 70 plus 2 times the patient's age. He also reviewed recommendations for special situations such as life-threatening asthma, hyperkalemia, and pregnancy-related resuscitation. He highlighted the importance of rapid cycle deliberate practice for CPR training and mentioned ongoing research on improving teamwork and leadership in resuscitation efforts. He provided an overview of the new American Heart Association CPR guidelines, including changes to foreign body airway obstruction techniques, emphasis on minimizing chest compression interruptions, and updated recommendations for epinephrine administration in cardiac arrest situations. He shared the upcoming NPRP PEDS Readiness Assessment, scheduled for release in March 2026. Dr. Davis advised that the PowerPoint will be shared through the pediatric listserv.
