She suggested strengthening relationships with birthing centers and midwives to ensure better communication and care when patients need to be transferred. Another goal she wants to work on in this subcommittee is goals related to health equity and improving access to care. The group agreed to use their platform and SETRAC to facilitate these improvements. She also opened the floor for additional feedback on what goals this committee should focus on for 2026. Dr. Burroughs updated the group on the progress of the primary cesarean rate data project, noting that the written proposal had been submitted to the data committee for review, with the next steps being to collect data in the coming month. Dr. Roberts provided updates on two projects: the congenital syphilis project, which has established data definitions and instruction guides for program managers, and the Memorial Hermann whole blood transfusion initiative. TMC has been successfully implementing whole blood massive transfusion protocols on labor and delivery for six months, with Woodlands Memorial Hermann recently rolling out the program to trauma centers. The next phase will focus on non-trauma level 3 hospitals gaining whole blood banking capabilities. Grace gave an update on the SETRAC Maternal Data Timeline. Grace presented an overview of maternal data metrics collected from July 2021 to September 2025, noting trends in packed red blood cell transfusions and blood pressure treatment. The committee discussed upcoming changes to data reporting, including the removal of depression and substance use screening metrics. She reminded all the members of the data submissions requirement for SETRAC	The committee has no further recommendations.
