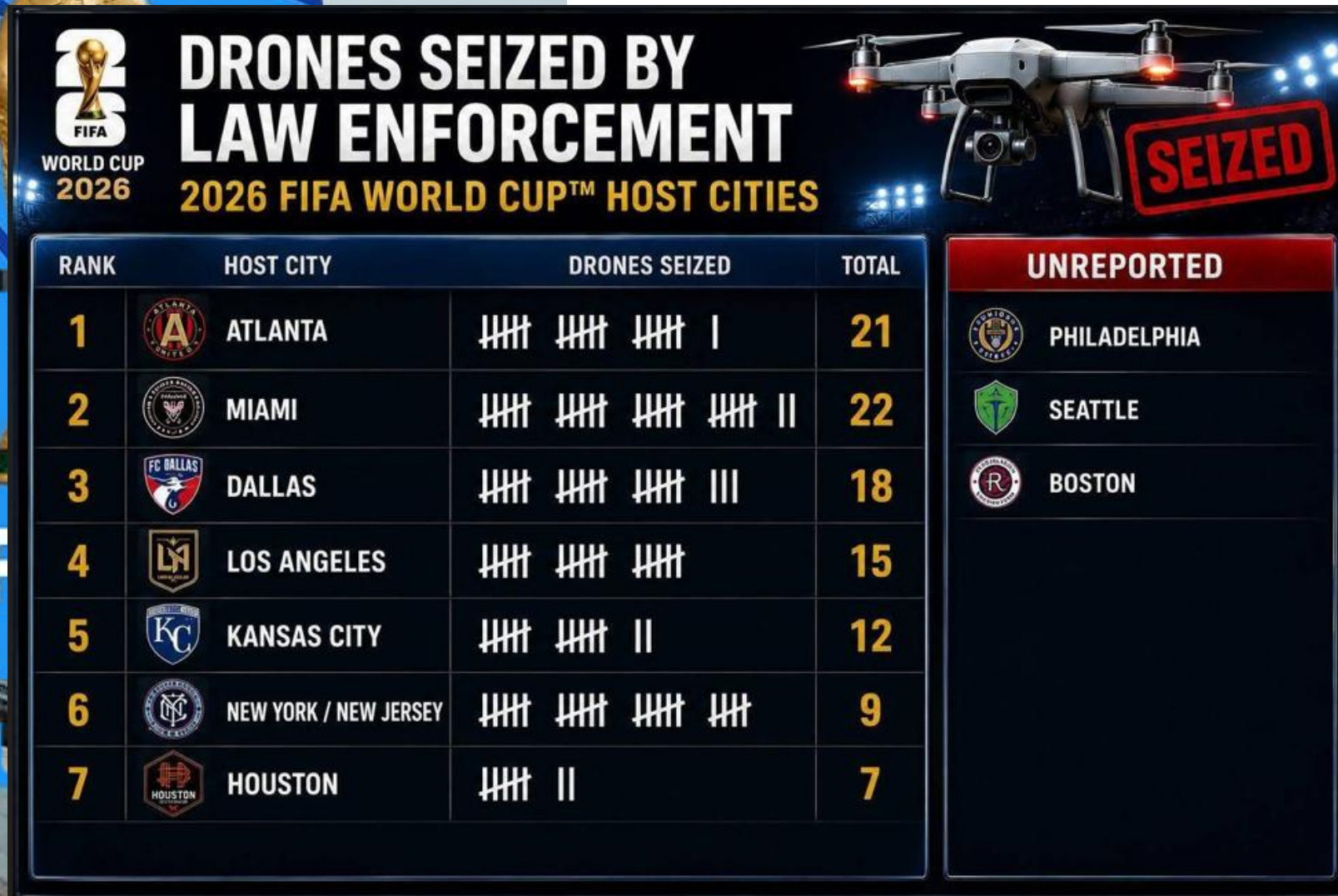

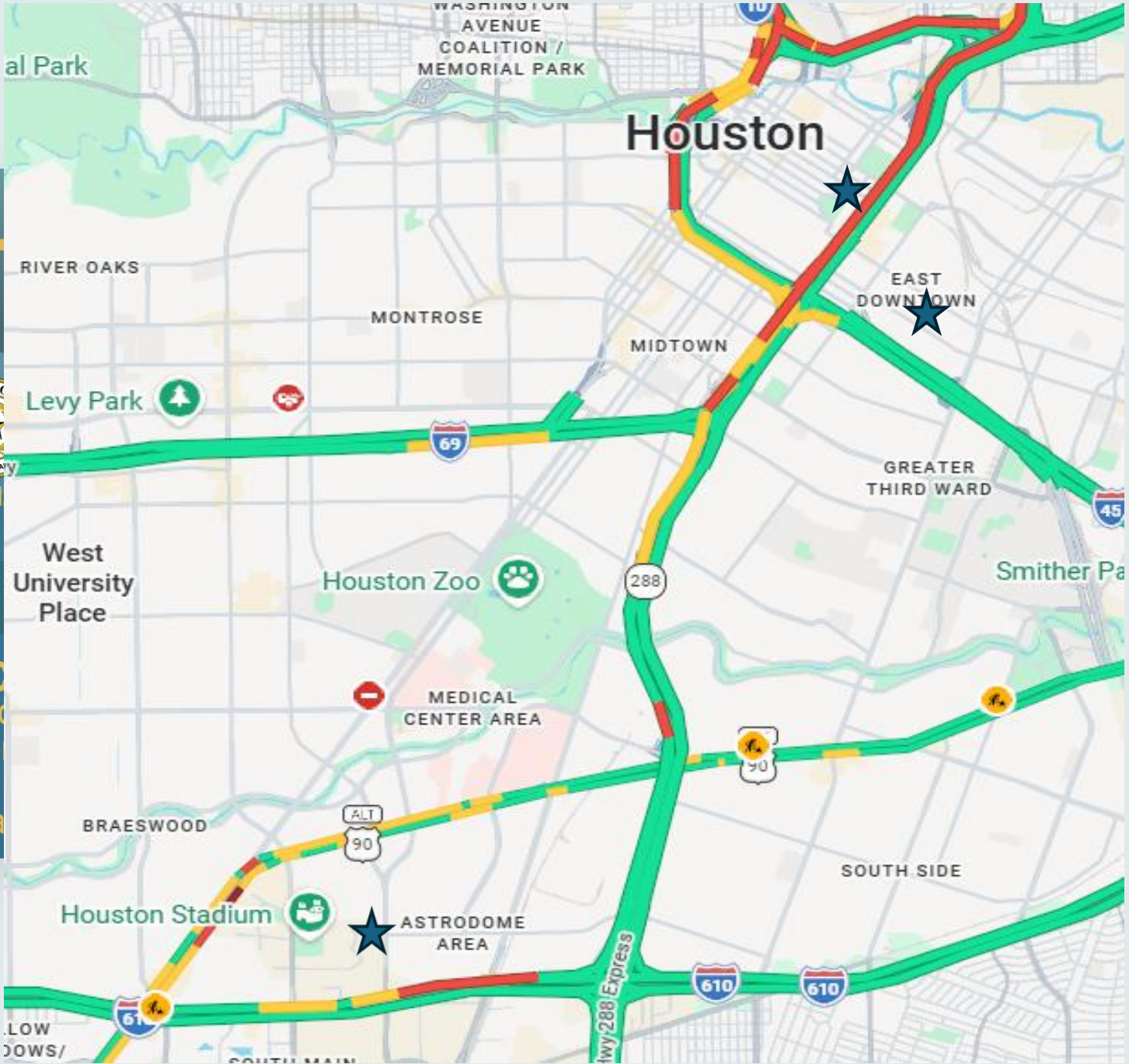

## Detailed Forecast

**Today** A chance of showers and thunderstorms before noon, then showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm between noon and 1pm, then a chance of showers and thunderstorms after 1pm. Partly sunny, with a high near 88. East wind 5 to 15 mph becoming north in the afternoon. Winds could gust as high as 20 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New rainfall amounts of less than a tenth of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms.

**Tonight** A 10 percent chance of showers and thunderstorms before 7pm. Partly cloudy, with a low around 79. Northwest wind 5 to 10 mph becoming south in the evening.

**Thursday** Mostly sunny, with a high near 93. Heat index values as high as 109. South wind 5 to 10 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph.

**Thursday Night** Partly cloudy, with a low around 81. South wind around 10 mph.

**Juneteenth** Partly sunny, with a high near 93. South wind 5 to 10 mph.

**Friday Night** A 30 percent chance of showers and thunderstorms after 1am. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 80.

**Saturday** A 30 percent chance of showers and thunderstorms, mainly before 1pm. Partly sunny, with a high near 91.

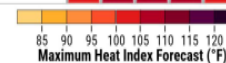

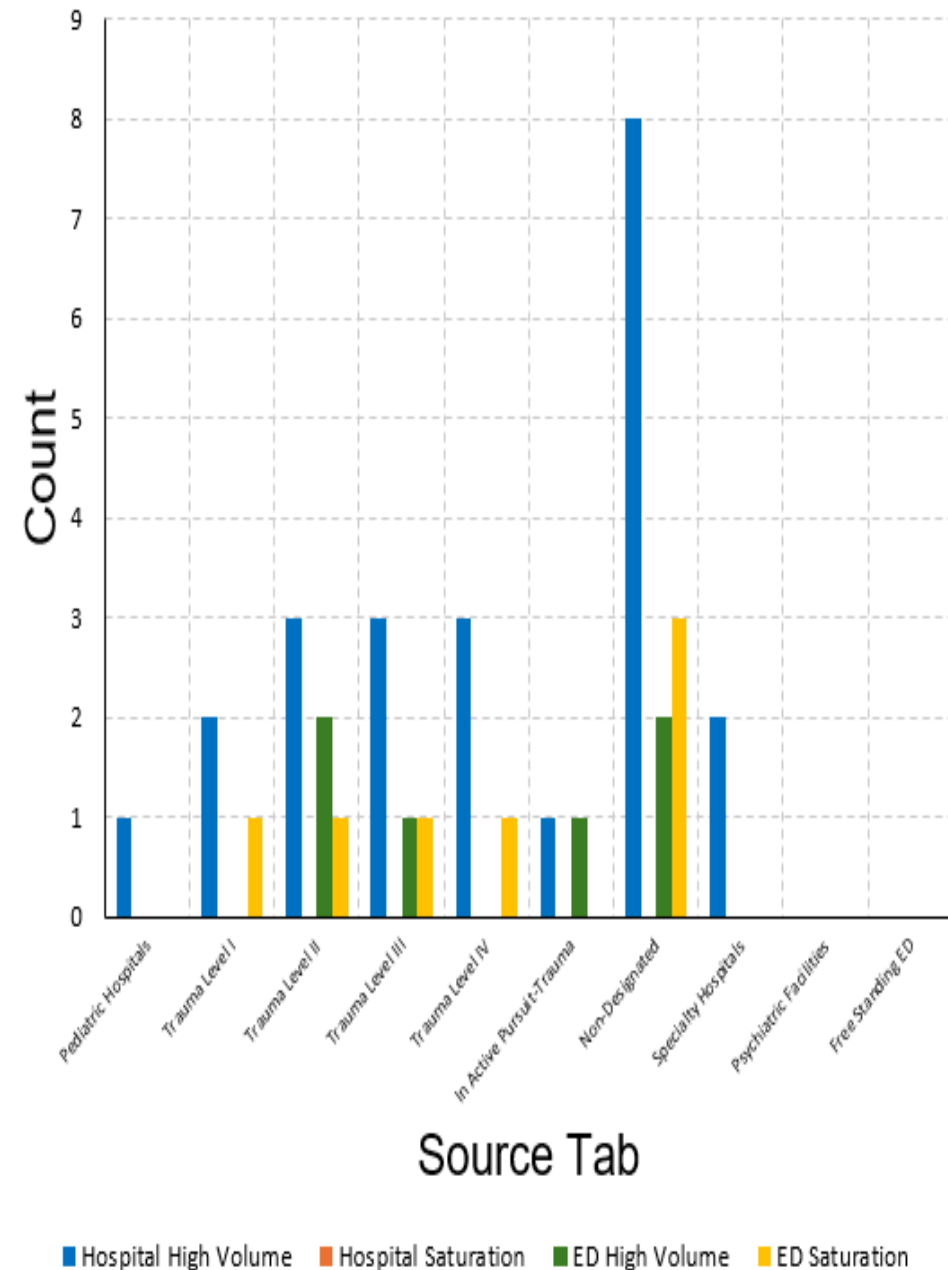

# Ebola Updates

- As of June 15<sup>th</sup> – DRC has 837 confirmed cases w/196 confirmed deaths
  - Uganda reported 19 confirmed with 2 confirmed deaths w/ 1 probable case and 1 probable death
  - No confirmed in the US
  - **RISK TO PUBLIC REMAINS LOW!**
- 
- As of the report on 6/13/2026:
    - 252 PUM in Texas
    - 41 in SETRAC region
  - **Regional IDRUC plans in place**

# MISSING PERSONS REPORT

- As FIFA is heating up, we want to provide a very straightforward and easy process to report missing persons should someone arrive at your facility looking for a sick or injured person. (Related to the FIFA World Cup)
- We are providing access to a form that is available in multiple languages to assist with reporting a missing person. NOTE, this is meant to be utilized if the missing person is presumed to be part of the FIFA event, as either a participant or a fan.
- The steps to follow if someone comes to your facility looking for a missing person are:
  1. Determine if the missing person is at your facility and follow your normal process for reunification if they are located at your facility.
  2. IF they are not at your facility, utilize the missing persons form found at this URL

Or this QR Code can be provided for ease of access on a mobile device. The reporting party can leverage this QR Code if necessary as it can be changed to multiple languages and allows for uploading pictures of the missing person etc.
