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# FIFA World Cup Pulsara Quick Reference Guide - Hospital

## Purpose

Provide operational guidance for hospital personnel to support patient tracking, situational awareness, and regional healthcare coordination associated with FIFA World Cup 2026 operations.

## Identified Pulsara FIFA Incidents

These incidents will be created within Pulsara for the duration of FIFA World Cup 2026 operations and will be utilized by EMS and hospital partners to support standardized patient tracking and regional situational awareness.

- FIFA Fanfest – EADO 2026
  - Zone: Bell Street, Chartres Street, Texas Avenue, Emancipation Avenue
- FIFA Fanfest – Sugar Land 2026
  - 15958 City Walk, Sugar Land, TX 77479
- FIFA Futbol – The Woodlands 2026
  - 2099 Lake Robbins Dr, The Woodlands, TX 77380
- FIFA Games – Houston Stadium 2026
  - 3 NRG Park, Houston, TX 77054
- FIFA Mile March 2026

- Agencies should anticipate traffic disruptions and may wish to avoid the following areas between approximately 0845 and 1030 hours:
  - Greenbriar Drive from University Boulevard to Fannin Street
  - Cambridge Street from East Road southward along the march route
- FIFA General Operations 2026
  - “Catch all” for patients who are in the region for FIFA but not associated with a pre-identified event or an MCI that would require a separate event creation.

## Operational Flowchart

- Hospital receives the patient either POV or via EMS. **(Hospitals can add any patient to any incident within a 250-mile radius see reference page for instructions).**
- If a patient that is associated with FIFA arrives at your facility by POV or EMS and has not been previously entered in Pulsara, a wristband should be applied and input into Pulsara under the appropriate incident.
- **“What incident should I put the patient in?”**
  - If the patient is arriving from a pre-identified site or incident listed above, they should be entered into the corresponding Pulsara incident, with their country of residence documented in the Chief Complaints/Notes section.
    - **Example:** A patient arrives POV or is transported by EMS without a wristband or Pulsara channel created from FIFA event: A wristband should be applied, and patient should be entered into Pulsara under the appropriate incident with their country of residence (e.g., Germany or Argentina) documented in the Chief Complaints/Notes section.
    - **Example:** A patient visiting Houston for the FIFA World Cup arrives by POV or EMS from a public location not associated with a pre-identified FIFA site: The patient should be entered into the “General FIFA 2026” incident, with their country of residence (e.g., Brazil or Mexico) documented in the Chief Complaints/Notes section.
