Presenter: Melanie Aluotto Topic: New Business Hurricane Beryl Impact, Challenges & Learnings	Kate asked Melanie to start with giving an update from the SETRAC debrief on Hurricane Beryl. Melanie informed all the members that, we are still dealing with impacts of Hurricane Beryl as a region. She shared a few processes and roles SETRAC played being activated in the Hurricane preparedness and recovery. She stated SETRAC was in a level 1 activation. Some task SETRAC assigned strike teams for 911 providers to offload the huge influx of calls throughout the region. SETRAC assigned strike teams to hospitals to offload patients. SETRAC also was responsible for setting up shelter at NRG for patients in facilities and facilitated their transport to and from the shelter. SETRAC also held twice daily conference calls with the healthcare facilities to properly assist with offloading patients. SETRAC assigned assets to help mitigate some of the needs across the region. SETRAC also coordinated oxygen delivery for those in need in the region. Melanie also shared some the challenges and Learnings which was mainly communication issues between the different agencies and facilities. There were a few questions and open discussions on different processes on this topic. Kate gave all the members the opportunity to share and discuss any Hurricane Beryl impacts on their facility and how they handled any challenges. A few hospitals talked about their impact and struggles during the storm, one specifically talked about how to use down time once their system went down, another facility talked about working on generator power for an extended pd of time.
